DMR Family Reunion Scholarship Application

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be accepted into an accredited 2- or 4-year College or University **OR** already be enrolled in a 2- or 4-year College or University.
2. Must have a minimum cumulative **GPA of 2.5 or higher.**
3. Must provide **3 letters of recommendation** from **NON-FAMILY** members. There must be 2 from an academic source (teacher, principal, administrator, etc.) & 1 from community member (pastor, community leader, etc.)
4. Must be a member of Dumas, McAuley Robinson Family
5. Parent(s) must be in good standing prior to Family Reunion with dues paid for last two (2) consecutive reunions.
6. Write a 400-600 word essay about 1 or more ways you have impacted your community in a positive way.
7. Winners are encouraged to attend the 2025 DMR Family Reunion in Charlotte, NC, and be prepared to demonstrate oral communication skills upon receipt of the scholarship.
